

GETA celebrates World Wheelchair Tennis Day

More than 80 wheelchair tennis players, from three provinces in South Africa, took to the tennis courts in celebration of the annual International Tennis Federation (ITF) World Tennis Day, on Monday (March 4).

This was an effort to promote able-bodied and wheelchair tennis, and increase participation among young players around the globe.

World Tennis Day in Ekurhuleni, Gauteng, Limpopo and the Western Cape centred on grassroots level camps and tournaments.

Throughout the month of March, Wheelchair Tennis South Africa will roll out 12 regional camps across the 46 centres in the nine provinces, to support World Tennis Day with their own grassroots and centre activities, to attract new participants to the sport.
